The current situation is that we still have a reasonable buffer after paying for the solar panels. Income is steady.

Market Harborough BS is proving problematic in moving signatories over- we discussed moving the account to an internet bank account in future for ease of access.

Fabric and facilities:

- Solar panels update: EON were not able to provide the service for the quote price offered due to having to charge VAT. We have now committed to go with Rutland Renewables, subject to the meter being an export meter rather than import. This allows us to measure the amount of electricity we can sell back to the grid. The quote is slightly cheaper than the original so we will have some funds left over for heating and lighting replacement etc.
- Tap replacement: This has been completed by Tony White. Many thanks were expressed by the committee for his time and effort in doing this task.
- Extension of cleaning hours: JS to ask SB to increase cleaner's hours to 2 hrs pw, preferably spread over the week.
