# Previous Minutes (Meeting 11th April 2024) review and agreement

## **Finance**

• Treasurer's report circulated with no material issues of note

## **Fabric and Facilities**

- BBQ purchased at a cost of £249.99
- New vacuum cleaner purchased for £160
- Village "container" to be used to store BBQ with PH to ascertain whether any requirement to dispense with superfluous items currently stored
- PAT testing completed with all items "passed" Christmas lights to be checked separately- TW
- Buildings & Contents renewal due on 25<sup>Th</sup> June. The Policy is arranged via Allied Westminster (VillageGuard product) with Underwriter changed this year from Aviva to Ecclesiastical with improved cover levels overall. Premium increased only modestly (+3%) with increase viewed as reasonable. The premium level is based on a 5-year commitment with the previous 5-year commitment having expired. Premium can principally only be increased by inflation adjustments.

**MP** to liaise with **JD** to ensure Policy renewed by due date. N.B. 5 yearly rebuild valuation currently being undertaken for discounted fee and may result in premium amendment depending on outcome of PV.

# Social Committee/Events update.

- Quiz night was a great success and also made a profit of £88.91 plus, effectively, £106 on drinks.
- BBQ (31<sup>st</sup> Aug. 24)- it was agreed that Adult ticket prices would be reduced from £10 to £8 this year with option to increase drinks prices to compensate if viewed as appropriate. Other activities due on that day (Dance) to be cancelled to allow time for set up etc. **Social Ctee to advise EP** in this regard.
